### SPIRIT & SACRAMENT: WASHED NEW

Bottom Line: God wants us to both honor sacraments, but let the Spirit spontaneously move in our lives. Only Jesus makes us new!

## Summary of Main Points

- 1. Despite our best efforts, only the Spirit of God draws us into righteousness, pointing us to Jesus. Acts 15:28, Romans 3:23
- 2. Only Jesus Christ can make all things new, not our faithful practices.
- 3. The Spirit of God brings the Biblical sacraments to life.
- 4. The Spirit of God makes a relationship with Jesus vibrant and meaningful! He is someone to be loved.
