## **Group Discussion Guide** | Where Your Treasure Is | April 30, 2023

Bottom Line: "Where your treasure is is where your trust is." // Main Points

- Where your treasure is will either last or rot.
  - Scripture MT 6:19-21
  - Key Notes Often we spend money only on ourselves, a lifestyle that ends with our last breath. God invites us into a more meaningful way of living - spending/giving \$ to things that last and build lives impacting eternity.
- Where your treasure is reveals who is in charge.
  - Scripture 2 Corinthians 9:10
    - Only money is the most visible sign of what worship. We can't hide what we give our money to. God wants to Lord - given to first.
    - God will cause a change in our hearts and teach us to be generous. In doing so, His will accomplished-needs are met, ministries work, Gospel preached.
- Where your treasure is is where your trust is.
  - Scripture MT 6:33
    Key Notes My spending habits reveal what I've placed my trust in.
